As a Reliability Engineer, he developed life testing and reliability predictions for hydraulic systems and new development. He has five patents related to steering systems, two in production.

He has conducted extensive research and published papers on p-value estimates for goodness of fits, methods to analyze mixtures of failure modes, and estimates of missing data.
